

Ministerial Resolution
No. 0133 of the 31st of March of 1999

Seeing and considering:

- That the Political Constitution of the State (in its Article 7, section a,) in agreement with the Article 158 says that every person has a fundamental right to life, health and security, and that the State has the obligation of defending the human capital by protecting the health of the population:
- That the Health Code of the Republic of Bolivia in its Article 3 says: It is a duty of the Executive Power through the Health Authority, the definition of the national health policy, the regulation, planning, control and coordination of all activities in the national territory, in public and private institutions, without exception
- That the Law No. 1788, of the organization of the Executive Power, in its Article 11 establishes the specific attributions of the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, to norm, supervise, and evaluate the National Health System, aimed to improving the quality of care in the health services according to the Strategic Health Plan (PBS, in Spanish):
- That, through _____ implements the Basic Health Insurance, in whose benefits package it's included the treatment of bleeding in the first half of pregnancy:

It is resolved:

- To adequate the obstetric emergency services to improve the quality of care, decreasing the intervention costs and the inpatient staying times in the facilities through the introduction of the Manual Endo-Uterine Aspiration (AMEU. in Spanish), in the Post Abortion Care facilities (PAC).

The General Health Services Directorate and the Patient Care Unit will proceed to the development of the corresponding guidelines and processes for the application of this Resolution.
